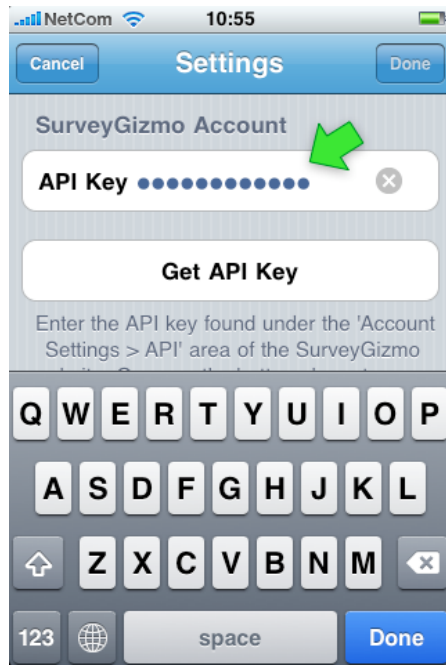


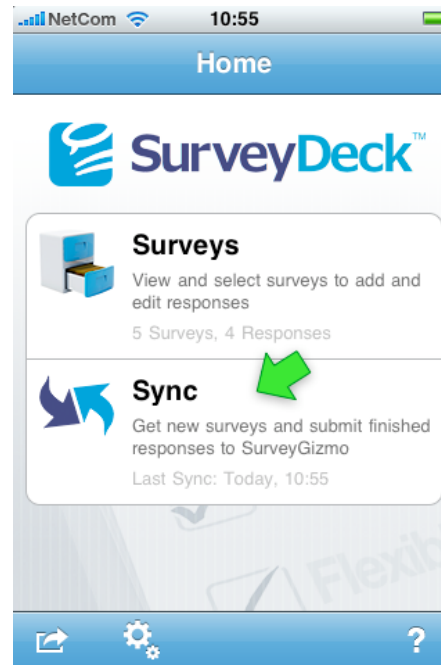
# A Beginner's Guide to SurveyDeck

We'll show you how to get your surveys into SurveyDeck, how to create responses, and how to get them back onto SurveyGizmo. This walkthrough assumes you already have an account with SurveyGizmo, and that you've 'Launched' at least one survey.

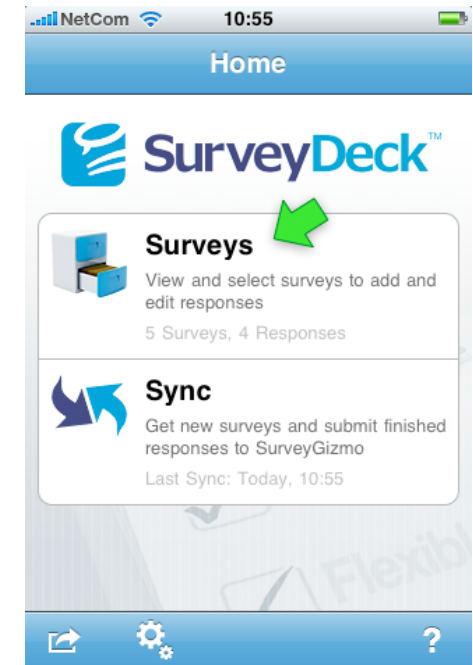
- 1 Enter your SurveyGizmo account's API Key, which is found under 'Account Settings > API' on the SurveyGizmo website.



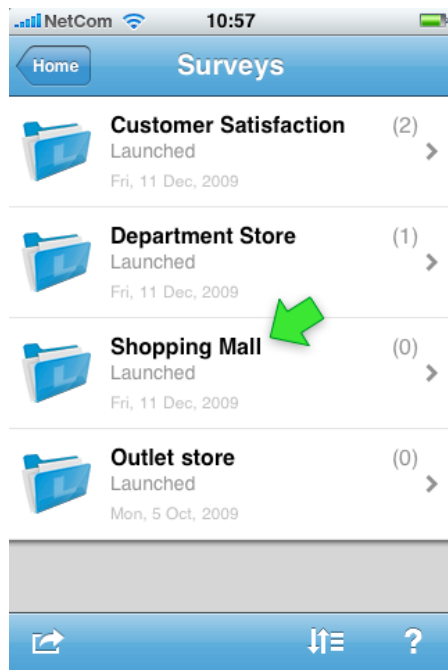
- 2 Press the Sync button to get all your 'Launched' surveys. Those whose status are 'In Design' or 'Closed' don't go to the iPhone.



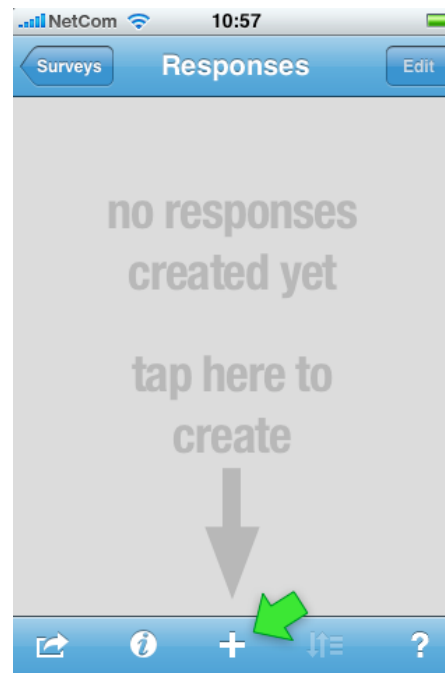
- 3 After your surveys have been synced, press the 'Surveys' button to list your surveys.



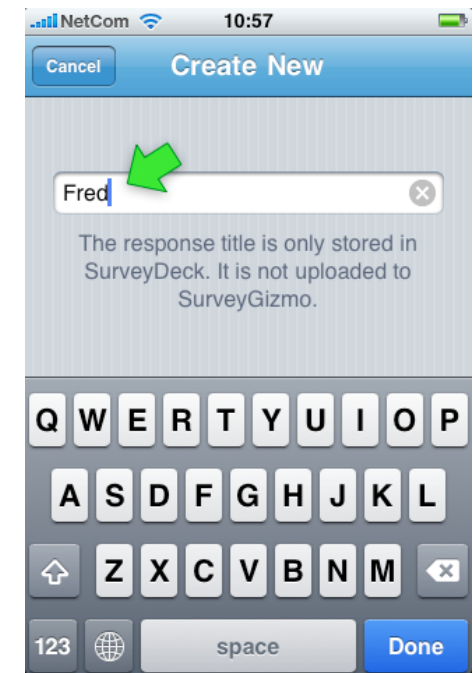
4 A list of your surveys is shown on the Surveys screen. For this example, we'll select the 'Shopping Mall' survey to show existing Responses for this survey, and to create a new Response.



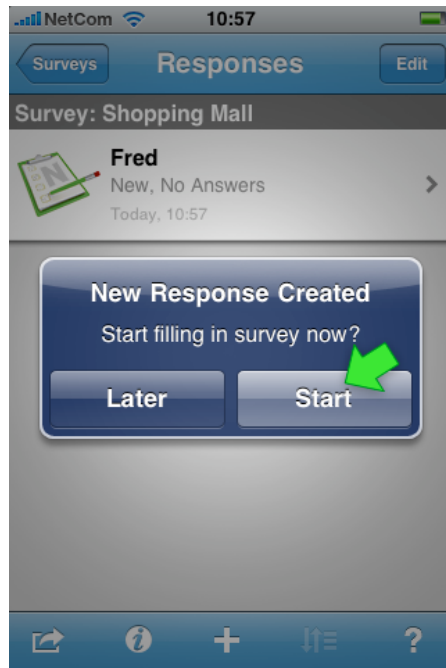
5 As this is the first time this survey has been downloaded, there are no existing Responses to list. Press the + button to create a new Response.



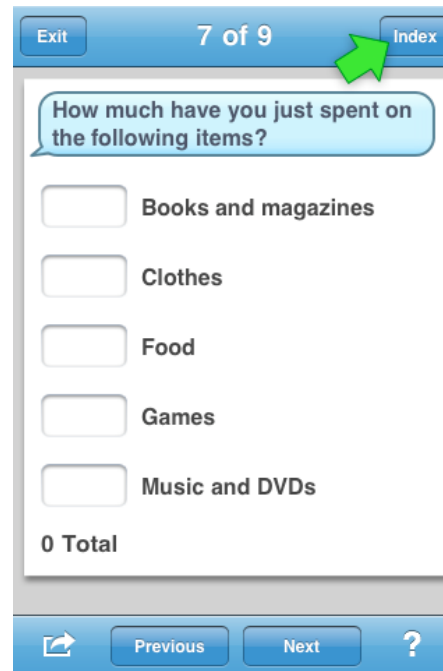
6 You'll be asked to enter a title for the new Response.



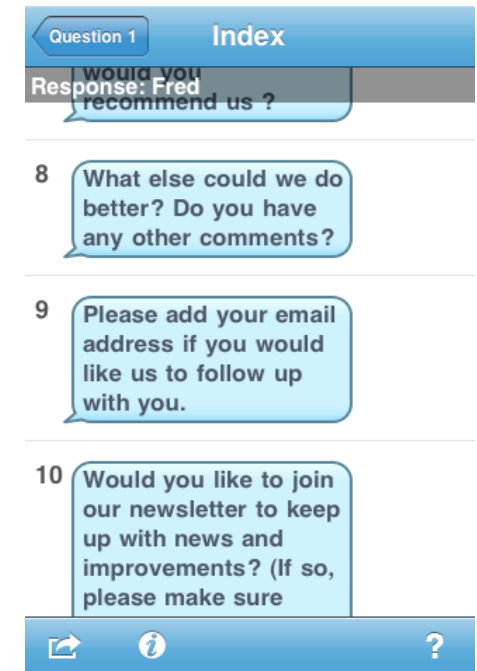
7 You then have the choice of either starting the survey right away, or leaving it for later. Select 'Start'.



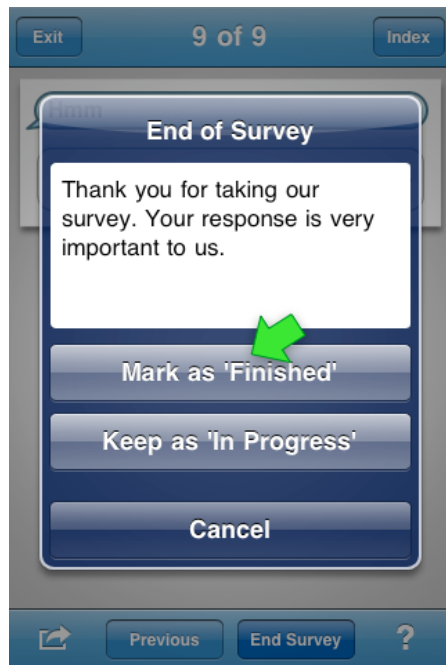
8 The question screens are shown, where you can fill in the survey. Press the 'Index' button to show a list of all the questions.



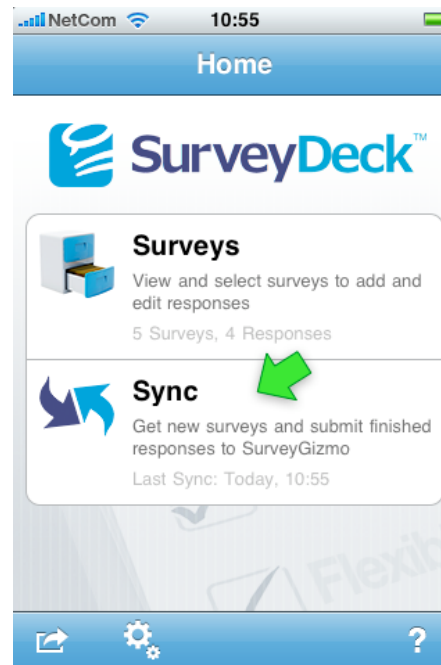
9 You can jump to any question you wish from the 'Index'.



10 When you reach the end of the survey, you're given the choice of leaving the survey as 'In Progress', which means it doesn't get submitted when you sync, or 'Finished', which means it gets submitted when you sync. Select 'Finished'.



11 Press the 'Sync' button on the Home screen once again to submit the response you just created. Now you can check your SurveyGizmo account on the website to see the new Response. Multiple Responses can of course be submitted at the same time.



12 The title you give the Response can't be submitted to SurveyGizmo, but if necessary, you can refer to the 'Response ID' on the Response Info screen to cross reference. You could also create a response title question in the survey designer, as the first question.
